Here is information about each chapter's policy on recommendation letters. It is important to note that none of the chapters at UCF require recommendation letters, it is simply optional for potential new members to have them submitted on their behalf.

Alpha Delta Pi

Do you accept recommendation letters?

Yes we accept recommendation letters.

Who can write a recommendation letter?

Any ADPI Alumnae, and ADPI Collegiate Members for PNMs that are not attending the same university.

When do you need it?

August 9th.

Where/how do I send it to you?

Do you accept recommendation letters?

Yes.

When do you need it?

Do you accept recommendation letters?

We do not accept any recommendation letters.

Do you accept recommendation letters?

Yes.

Who can write a recommendation letter?

Any alumna in good standing.

When do you need it?

Ideally, by the start of recruitment.

Where/how do I send it to you?

We accept both electronic (<http://www.deltazeta.org/join-us/recommend-a-member/>) or by mail sent to the CCD of the chapter or directly to chapter leadership. We currently do not have a CCD so letters can be sent to me via this email address.

Gamma Phi Beta

Do you accept recommendation letters?

Yes.

Who can write a recommendation letter?

A recommendation letter must be sent in from a Gamma Phi Beta member or alumna member.

When do you need it?

We would prefer to have any letters sent in at least one week prior to the start of formal recruitment.

Where/how do I send it to you?

Any Gamma Phi Beta member can sign into their account on our website and there is an option to send in a recommendation letter on there.

Kappa Alpha Theta

Do you accept recommendation letters?

Yes.

Who can write a recommendation letter?

Alumni or current members in good standing.

When do you need it?

Earlier the better, preferably before Round 1. Let's say August 10th.

Where/how do I send it to you?

Kappa Delta

Do you accept recommendation letters?

While Kappa Delta does not require recommendations for women to be considered for membership, recommendations offer a beneficial introduction to the chapter.

Who can write a recommendation letter?

An alumna in good standing from any Kappa Delta chapter may write a recommendation for a potential new member. A collegiate member in good standing can write a recommendation for a young woman who is going through recruitment at another school, not her own.

When do you need it?

Recommendations and Legacy Introductions Forms are due the first day of the month in which the chapter's recruitment begins. Chapters often prefer to receive recommendations earlier, but chapters are expected to consider these forms, sent online and via traditional mail service, up until the first of the month in which they begin recruitment.

Where/how do I send it to you?

Online Recommendation and Legacy Introduction Forms are now available to members by logging into the Member Portal (<https://members.kappadelta.org/>). Please note that electronic recommendations are preferred. However, you may access printable versions of the recommendation form here
