FAQ's

Does your chapter have a chapter facility?

- Our chapter has a chapter facility that accommodates up to 35 members. Each room is set up in a two-by-two style, with two members per room sharing a bathroom with the adjoining room. The facility is owned and managed by our House Corporation, and about 82% of member dues go toward maintaining and operating the house. These contributions help ensure the house is properly managed and maintained for everyone.

Are your chapter women required to live in the chapter facility?

- Living in the chapter facility is not required for our members. Those who are interested can apply through a formal application process. Priority is first given to executive board members, followed by selection based on seniority within the chapter. We also consider each member's level of involvement, including leadership roles, attendance at chapter events, participation in organizations outside of Panhellenic, and academic performance.

Does your chapter have a meal plan, and is it required?

- Our chapter offers a meal plan that is required for all members. Meals are provided Monday through Thursday, with both lunch and dinner available each day. For members living in the house, lunch is also provided on Fridays. In addition, breakfast options like bagels, toast, and coffee are available throughout the week, along with snacks that members can grab at any time. If a member has a medical condition that prevents them from participating in the meal plan, an exemption option is available.

Does your national organization offer scholarships?

- The Alpha Delta Pi Foundation offers a variety of scholarships to support members in their academic journeys, helping both undergraduate and graduate students offset the cost of their education. These scholarships are funded through donations and are awarded based on factors such as academic achievement, leadership, campus involvement, and financial need. Members apply through an annual application process, and recipients are selected to recognize their commitment to both their studies and the values of Alpha Delta Pi.

Do you offer a payment plan?

- Our chapter offers flexible payment plans, with up to 10 options that are set up with the Vice President of Finance at the beginning of the year. Maintaining financial transparency is a top priority at ADPI, which is why members can work directly with the VP of Finance to choose a plan that best fits their needs. We use a system called Revela, which allows members to view exactly what each payment plan will look like based on their specific dues, including scheduled charge dates. Revela also gives members the option to pay by credit card or bank account, with payments automatically processed according to the selected plan. We understand that circumstances can change, and funds may not always be available when a payment is scheduled. With Revela, members have the flexibility to cancel their payment plan at any time and continue making payments at their own pace, as long as the balance is paid by the deadline.

Chi Omega provides both merit-based and need-based scholarships: merit-based awards recognize academic achievement and leadership, while need-based scholarships offer financial support to members facing hardship. Applicants for both must be in good standing with their chapter.

- We offer flexible payment plan options for both new and initiated members. New members may choose to pay their dues in full or in two installments, while initiated members may pay in full or split their dues into three installments.
