We encourage you all to come with a specific plan or punishment to be taken when events like these may occur.”

- Key takeaways: UCF Panhellenic does not condone the use of Greek Rank. Use of this site can result in a judicial hearing. Your chapter should have a plan on how to deal with and punish anyone found using this website.
